- Clause.1 The Technical specifications contained herein shall be read in conjunction with other documents of bid.
- Clause.2 The technical specification in accordance with which the entire Work shall be carried out and completed by the contractor, shall comprise of the following
- Clause.3.0 **TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**
- Clause.3.1 All works shall be carried out as per National Building code-2016, IS-456, IS-800 and other relevant IS codes.
- Clause.3.2 For road work (Approach Road and other road) specification as per I.R.C & M.O.S.T. shall be followed.
- Clause.3.3 If so far any Amended/ Modified/ added clause may come in conflict or be inconsistent with any of the provisions of the said specifications under reference, the latest Amended/Modified/ Added Clause/latest edition of corresponding standards shall always prevail.
- Clause.3.4 All E&M works shall be carried out as per CPWD specification 2023 (part 1&2) including latest amendment / Corrigendum slips. if any provision is not available in above specification Part-1 & 2, relevant IS codes will be referred.
- Clause.3.5 In the absence of any definite provisions on any particular issue in the aforesaid specifications, reference may be made to the specifications of BIS Codes, where even the above codes are silent, the specifications of ODISHA P.W.D., CPWD specification issued from time to time shall apply. If none of the foregoing applies, the construction and completion of works shall conform to sound Engineering practice as approved by the Engineer in charge. In case of any dispute arising out of the interpretations of the above, the decision of the Engineer in charge shall be final and binding on the bidder.
