4. The Bidder must possess compatible Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of Class II or Class III.

5. Bids shall be received only through "online" on or before to 6.00 P.M. of Dt. 01.10.2026.

6. Bids received online shall be opened at 3.30 P.M. on Dt. 03.10.2026 in the Office of the undersigned in presence of the bidders who wish to attend. Bidders who participated in the bid can witness the opening of bids after logging in to the site through their DSC. If the Office happens to be closed on the last date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

7. The bidders are requested for making online payment such as EMD and Tender Paper cost as detailed at column 4 and 5 respectively via RTGS/NEFT and to make the payment at least one day in advance to the last day of Bid submission as certain amount of time required for settlement, after the payment is made and to avoid technical issue in last minute.

8. Since online payment of EMD and TP has been introduced in Jharsuguda Municipality 2nd time you are requested go through the DO's and Dont's annexed with the DTCN issued by Govt. Of Odisha, Govt. E-Procurement system of NIC.

GENERAL CONDITION OF CONTRACT

1. The work is to be completed within **60 Days** from the date of issue of the work order.
2. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
3. Conditional tenders containing terms and condition are liable for rejection.
4. The Contractors are required to furnish evidence of ownership/leased or hired of machineries such as concrete mixer, vibrater, centering materials P.R.R., Vibromax Paves and Vehicles required for the concerned work failing which tenders will not be taken into consideration.
5. The Contractor shall furnish a certificate along with tender to the effect that he is not related to any officer in the rank of an Assistant Engineer and above. If the fact subsequently proved to be false, the contract is liable to be rescinded.
6. The tenderers are to submit along with the tender a note regarding his experience on construction of similar type of works from competent authority.
 - a Name of the work;
 - b Estimated Cost;
 - c Date of Commencement;
 - d Actual date of completion;
 - e Work order no and date;
 - f Other details if any;
7. Additional Performance Security shall be obtained from the bidder when the bid amount is less than estimated cost put to tender as per Works Department, Govt. of Odisha, Office Memorandum No. - 07764600022025 173/W, BBSR Dt. 03.01.2026. In such an event, only the successful bidders who has quoted less bid price/rates than the estimated cost put to tender shall have to furnish the exact Amount of differential cost i.e. estimated cost put to tender minus the quoted amount as additional Performance Security APS in shape of Demand Draft/Term Deposit Receipt pledged in favour of the Executive Officer, Jharsuguda Municipality within Seven Days, otherwise the bid shall be cancelled and the security deposit shall be forfeited. Further, proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against the bidder.
8. If the rate quoted by the SC and ST category contractors within 10% above the lowest valid tender (L1) in that case the works department notification i.e. Para -2 of resolution No. 27748 Dt. 11.10.1977 will be implemented, then the tender shall be finalised by the tender accepting authority through a transparent manner. In this regard the winner bidder has to deposit the APS within 7 Seven days after finalization of the bid, failing which subsequently 2nd winner will be consider for award of the bid. Subsequently 3rd winner will be consider for award if the 2nd winner didn't deposit the APS from day 8 to 14 days from the date of lottery.
9. **Additional Performance Security (APS):**
As per Works Department Office Memorandum No.173 dated 03.01.2026 and clarification issued vide Works Department Office Memorandum No. 632 dated 09.01.2026, Additional Performance Security (APS) shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under:
 - i. **Where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid:** No additional performance guarantee/security percentage is required.
 - ii. **Where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid:** The additional performance guarantee/security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
 - iii. **Where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid:** The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;
 - iv. The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more.

- v. The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.
 - vi. **Justification for abnormally low bids** shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the Bid price, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the Bidder, including detailed price analyses of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document. If, after evaluating the price analyses, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the Procuring Entity may reject the Bid/ Proposal. However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.
- 9.2.** The successful bidder shall deposit the APS amount within 07 (seven) days from the date of communication to the bidder. The Additional Performance Security should be in the form of Insurance Surety Bond, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Bank Guarantee, TDR including e-Bank Guarantee from any of Scheduled Commercial Bank or Online Payment; in favour of Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation, Bhubaneswar. The BG should remain valid at least till one month after expiry of stipulated date of completion of the work and Defect Liability Period as per the LOA.
10. No escalation of cost in respect of labour, POL, materials and other item. If any, will be entertained during the course of execution of work.
 11. The bidder should have executed similar nature of work / PSU's may participate having similar work experience, in this regard he/ she should enclose the completion certificate.
 12. M-40 Grade paver to be used which will be confirm on testing in government laboratory, should meet the specification no extra charges will be paid.
 13. The tenders are required to furnish attested copies of valid PAN Card, GST Clearance Certificate, Labour License and valid Caste Certificate in case of ST/SC category contractors with original affidavit regarding claim of price preference if any as per rule for each tender at the time of uploading tender document to the website and originals of which are to be produced before date of opening, failing which the tender will be rejected without assigning any reason thereof.
 14. The bill of quantity for the work will be available up to Dt. 01.10.2026 during the period mentioned in the E-Tender.
 15. Each tenderer is expected to inspect the site of the proposed work to know the exact working condition before tendering his offer.
 16. The detail of work can be had in the office of Jharsuguda Municipality during office hours on any working days. Relevant ISI standard PWD/PHD Specification of Government of Odisha is to be followed during course of execution.
 17. On no account the contract work should be assigned or subject to sublet without prior approval of the Municipal Council, Jharsuguda and in such event the contract may be rescinded by Executive Officer, by giving a notice in writing, The contractor should be duly liable in dimity to the Municipality for any compensation payable by Municipality to any quarter and in such case the same would be recovered from the contractor.

18. The contractor should abide by the fair wages clause notified by the Government in Labour Department and in force during the period of execution and shall not pay less than the fair wage fixed by Government to the laborers engaged by him for the work.
19. The tenderer whose tender is accepted shall forthwith. On written intimation being given to him about acceptance of tender, make requisite initial security deposit and sign the agreement within 7 day of such intimation for due fulfillment of contract in the office of Executive Officer, Jharsuguda Municipality, failing which it be liable for forfeitures of the earnest money.
20. The Lowest Tendered shall submit the quality test certificate report of materials used in work as and when required.
21. The contractor shall use SAIL MS Rod/ Steel for the reinforcement work and approved grade of cement as per direction of the Engineering personnel for execution of the work.
22. The contractor should arrange at his own cost necessary T&P such as pump, vibrator, concrete mixer, roller, excavator, winch machine, concrete lifter, tractor, compressed concrete pump, scaffolding materials and etc., as would be required during execution of work.
23. The department has the right to inspect the work and can reject partly or fully each structure if found defective in their opinion.
24. No claim for compensation for any damage caused by rain or any other natural calamities during the execution of work will be entertained.
25. All safety measures are to be taken by the contractor during the execution and till final completion of work by the contractor at his own cost.
26. Under no circumstances interest is chargeable by the contractor for the due or additional dues if any payable to him for the work.
27. All tender received will remain valid for period of 90 days from the date of receipt of tender.
28. Payment will be made subject to availability of the fund with the Municipality.
29. In case of Cement Concrete road, use of concrete Vibrator is compulsory.
30. The contractor should be in a position to start the work within Seven days of receipt of Work Order.
31. All Contractor has to mandatorily submit valid E-mail and whatsapp phone no if it is not same as in License, as all the correspondent will be through Email/ whatsapp only. The authority will not be responsible for invalid Email/ Whatsapp.
32. In no case the completion time will be extended, the bidder should complete the work in the schedule time failing which action as deemed fit as per OPWD codal provision/ Odisha Municipal Act. 1950 will be initiated.
